Sir J.J. School of Art, Architecture and Design (Deemed to be University under de-novo category) was formed in 2023 and is governed by the University Grants Commission (UGC). It is a multidisciplinary University integrating Art, Architecture and Design, and carries forward the glorious legacy of the Sir J.J. School of Art, Sir J.J. College of Architecture and Sir J.J. Institute of Applied Art. The school was established in 1857 with a generous donation from Sir Jamshedji Jejeebhoy, noted philanthropist and city-father. Over a century and a half, the various schools on the South Mumbai campus have produced several international and national practitioners of art, architecture and design. Now, as an integrated (de novo) University, this education legacy continues, offering unique and emerging areas of knowledge in art, architecture and design not offered by conventional institutions to the next generation of creative professionals.

As per provision under Section 23 (B) (3) (a) of the University Grants Commission (Institutions Deemed to be Universities) Regulations 2023, the Government of Maharashtra has constituted the Search-cum-Selection Committee to recommend an eligible and suitable candidate for the post of Vice-Chancellor.

Applications/Nominations are invited from eminent academicians who fulfil the qualifications and experience prescribed for the post of Vice-Chancellor as per U.G.C. (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulation, 2018.

The interested eligible candidates/applicants can apply for the post as per the format of the application together with (i) Summary (Annexure-I) and (ii) No Objection and Vigilance Clearance Certificate (Annexure II) with all requisite documents arranged chronologically (in .doc and .pdf format). Additionally, they should provide write-up about their suitability for the post, write up about their vision for the University and name and contact details of the three referees (distinguished individuals well acquainted with the work of the applicant) along with reference letters. Institutions may also nominate suitable candidates for this post. However, all such candidates shall be required to send their CV in the prescribed format along with requisite documents.

The Search-cum-Selection Committee has appointed Prin. Ajay Bhamare, Pro Vice-Chancellor, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai 400 032 as the Nodal Officer. Nominations / Applications may be sent in the prescribed format in hard (4 copies) by post/courier in an envelope superscribed with “Application for the post of Vice-Chancellor, Sir J.J. School of Art, Architecture and Design” as well as soft copy to the Nodal Officer at the following address so as to reach on or before Tuesday, the 25th March 2025. Applications received thereafter shall not be entertained.
